

# **Pee-Wee Baseball**

## **Rules**

- 1. Ten batters per inning. On tenth batter the lead runner must be stopped before the inning is declared over unless the 3<sup>rd</sup> out is made.**
- 2. No player may advance more than one base when there is an overthrow at first base. If the first baseman makes a play on the runners after the overthrow then the runners may continue.**
- 3. Coaches will pitch to the players.**
- 4. Defensive pitcher must remain in the circle until the ball becomes live. Defensive pitcher must wear a heart guard and helmet at all times.**
- 5. Six inning games.**
- 6. All infielder's must stay behind the 30 foot mark on the 1<sup>st</sup> base line and 3<sup>rd</sup> base line.**
- 7. All batters are in the line-up. All players must play 3 innings in the field.**
- 8. Mercy Rule: 15 runs after 3 innings, 11 runs after 4 innings and 8 runs after 5 innings.**
- 9. Little League approved bats only. 2 ¼ barrel bats.**
- 10. All other rules will be played by the O.H.S.A.A Rule Book.**
